The programme will be led by Inspiring Learning, and students will be embarking on their NCS Mandated Programme adventure on **Monday 24th June 2024**. They will be leaving HVH at 10am and travelling to Kingswood residential site in North Wales, where they will be spending 4 nights, before returning to HVH on **Friday 29th June 2024 at approximately 2pm**.

We have secured 40 fully funded places on this exciting adventure, and would love to see as many students as possible taking part. All food and drink will be included, as well as outdoor activities and workshops to increase learner confidence and real-world readiness.
